

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

With an overall 2.5% January capacity gain, passenger traffic at EWR grew 3.9%. Domestic traffic outpaced international with a growth of 4.5%, supported by 3.4% gain in seat capacity. United/Continental led the domestic gains as it contributed a net of 52,000 passengers. Southwest and USAirways rounded up the top three as they each added a net of approximately 7,500 passengers. International traffic registered the first positive gains since August 2012 with growth of 2.6%. United/Continental led the growth with a net addition of nearly 11,000 passengers. Swiss Air was the second contributor, as it added an extra flight to Switzerland on a larger A330 aircraft. Cargo continued to remain weak as it fell 1.4%. However, this is the smallest magnitude of decline since June 2011.
