LGA not only remained the fastest growing among our airports with January traffic growth of 11.5%, but also it set a new January record at three levels. Total January traffic level broke the previous 2008 record to reach, 1.92 million passengers. International passengers grew 44% as international seat capacity increased 56%, setting a new January record of 108,468. Domestic traffic also increased 10% on a 4% seat capacity gain, setting a new January of 1.8 million passengers. Domestic growth was attributable mainly to Delta which used its new slots to increase its domestic capacity by 39%, expanded services to 24 new domestic destinations, and added a net of 229,915 passengers. The international sector's record was led by West Jet which added a net of 17, 573 passengers followed by Delta with a net of nearly 12,000 mostly for services to Canadian destinations.
