Multiple snowstorms and squalls had their severest impact on domestic airlines at JFK, where passenger traffic declined a hefty 5.7%. In contrast, following a 5.2% seat capacity increase, international traffic expanded 5.9%, outpacing the domestic decline and keeping JFK's combined traffic just out of the red with a 0.2% increase. Moreover, this month became the best January ever for international traffic, surpassing the 2 million mark for the first time. Emirates, Delta and JetBlue together carried 72,100 more passengers on a combined 17% seat capacity increase. In the domestic market decline, JetBlue and American collectively carried 142,800 fewer passengers compared to last January. The cargo sector contracted 1.4% with domestic dropping 8.5% and international slightly up 0.5%.
