

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2014 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Following the same pattern as the rest of the East Coast airports, LGA's domestic passenger traffic suffered a 4.3% decrease, while international enjoyed a 10.8% increase. Since LGA is primarily a domestic gateway, the airport's total traffic contracted 3.4% because of the hefty domestic drop. Eight out of nine carriers serving domestic markets reported a combined traffic decline of 79,000 passengers, with JetBlue, United, Delta and US Airways each suffering a drop in excess of 15,000 passengers. The international sector showed strong growth with WestJet, Air Canada and Delta contributing the most to a 10.8% increase by expanding capacity to Montreal, Toronto and Bermuda.
