

Aviation Department

ACY's passenger traffic increased 6.3 percent following a 9.8 percent seat capacity expansion by Spirit Airlines, the only regular airline at the airport after United's departure in December last year. The incremental capacity increase was solely allocated to Orlando, which saw a 50 percent increase. In contrast, charter activity, which makes up approximately 6 percent of monthly passenger traffic, fell 21.2 percent. Short-term prospects remain positive for ACY as Air Canada is scheduled to begin services to Toronto in summer.
