

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at SWF declined 15.1% following a 12.8% seat capacity reduction. US Airways and Delta cut their capacity in excess of 15% to Philadelphia and Detroit respectively. This alone accounted for 99% of the passenger travel decrease at the airport. JetBlue kept its seat capacity to Orlando and Fort Lauderdale stable but carried 2.6% fewer passengers. Conversely, Allegiant Air sustained its momentum from last year and carried 10.9% more passengers to its Tampa destination.
