

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic performance at ACY grew by 3.3 percent. Spirit, the dominant carrier at the airport, grew 5.3 percent as it carried 4,905 additional passengers. Spirit's seat capacity, too, showed a solid increase - up 7.8 percent - to Fort Lauderdale, Fort Myers, Tampa, and West Palm Beach. International traffic, which is mostly charter, posted its second consecutive monthly drop - down 68.9 percent fall. Domestic charter activity fell 27.7 percent. As we have stated in previous airport traffic reports, the reduction in charter activity at ACY is related to a decline in the city's casino business.
