

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ DECEMBER 2017 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

JFK established two records in 2017, including a new overall mark for the sixth year in a row. The airport handled 59.3 million total passengers (+0.4 percent), representing 239,908 more passengers than 2016. In addition, the airport served a record 32.4 million international passengers – up 643,847 passengers (+2 percent). JFK's domestic traffic fell 1.5 percent in spite of a 1.2 percent gain in seat capacity. The passenger decline is attributable primarily to huge declines by AA, the absence of United. JFK's total cargo traffic grew 5.9 percent. All the growth was generated by the international sector, which grew a strong 7.3 percent – the first annual growth in international cargo since 2014. Domestic cargo fell 0.6 percent, primarily because FedEx carried 11,300 fewer tons compared to last year, as it utilized hubs elsewhere.
