

JFK's passenger traffic reached a record of 5.7 million passengers, while growing a modest 0.4 percent. Growth was led by the international sector's 4.3 percent increase - up 134,738 passengers. With a 5.3 percent expansion in international seats, JFK continued to lead our airports in international seat capacity. Domestic traffic fell by 4.5 percent, or 114,087 fewer passengers. With airlines increasing their domestic seats by 2.6 percent, planes were less full and load factors were down. JFK's total cargo activity fell 0.3 percent. The domestic sector experienced a 5.2 percent contraction. International cargo activity recovered from six consecutive months of negative performance, as it grew 0.8 percent, up 718 tons.
