

Aviation Department

JFK's total passenger volume reached a record 5.579 million travelers (+44,911 passengers/+0.8 percent). Growth was led by the domestic sector's new mark of 2.523 million travelers (+52,681 passengers/+2.1 percent). Delta set the pace with 76,694 additional passengers (+7.5 percent). It added 61,058 seats (+5.1 percent). JFK's international passenger traffic posted its first decline since August 2018 (-7,770 travelers/-0.3 percent). Delta (-84,398 passengers/-13.6 percent), American (-23,819 passengers/-11.4 percent) and Ethihad (-17,344 passengers/-40.2 percent) carried fewer passengers. JFK's total freight traffic (about 60 percent of the region's total cargo) fell by 4.1 percent (-4,874 tons). The international sector led the decline with a 6 percent slide (-5,730 tons). Domestic cargo grew by 3.8 percent (+856 tons).
