

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic was down 4.2%, a definite improvement over the 9.2% decline in first half traffic, on a 7.9% reduction in scheduled seats. Domestic traffic was down 3.2%, Newark's best monthly performance to date, on a 9.3% decrease in capacity. Leading the way in capacity reduction was Continental, decreasing departing seats by 92K in July or 9.2%, and American Airlines which flew 23K fewer seats or 23.7% less than last July.
