

Aviation Department

LaGuardia passenger traffic was down 1.5% on 7.0% fewer seats. This represents the smallest traffic decline since Oct. 2007 and is hopefully indicative of an imminent turnaround. All airlines reduced capacity but for JetBlue, which maintained the same level as it had last July, and Southwest which just started. Delta is slated to expand its operations when and if it closes its slot swap deal with US Airways.
