

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JULY 2012 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

For the first time this year monthly passenger traffic fell 2.9% in spite of a nearly 1% gain in seat capacity. Also for the first time this year both domestic and international traffic fell. International traffic fell 6.6%, reflecting the nearly 1.5% decline in Continental/United traffic and the absence of Eva, Air France and Iceland Express from the airport. Down 0.8%, domestic traffic fell for the first time this year as UA/CO remained flat and Delta, the 2nd ranking carrier at the airport carried 23,00 fewer passengers. Nevertheless, YTD July traffic remains somewhat encouraging at 3.1%. Cargo continued to remain weak as tonnage fell 7.4% pushing YTD July level down to 9.9%.
