

## Aviation Department

July passenger traffic was down slightly contracting 0.3 percent. Domestic and international passenger travel decreased 0.1 percent and 0.8 percent respectively. Compared to last year's monthly traffic, United, Delta and American collectively carried 62,000 fewer passengers on their domestic routes. The lion's share of this decline was attributed to United, a dominant carrier, which cut seat capacity to destinations in Florida, Pennsylvania, Arizona and Texas. Although domestic traffic is down slightly due to a decrease in capacity by the airlines, YTD traffic is up moderately at 0.4 percent. The cargo sector at EWR led the region's decline in July. Tonnage totals fell 18.5 percent, with domestic levels contracting 23.8 percent and international falling 8.7 percent.
