

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic increased 1.2 percent in July with international growing 3.6 percent and domestic contracting 1.6 percent. YTD is up 1.1 percent. Dominant carriers on domestic destinations such as JetBlue, Virgin America and Delta collectively carried 46,000 fewer passengers this month compared to last year because of major reductions in seat capacity. International traffic hit an all-time high for July, serving 2.7 million travelers and solidifying JFK's status as the premier international gateway in our region. Delta, JetBlue, Virgin Atlantic, Norwegian Air, Alitalia, ANA and Air France collectively carried 131,000 more passengers this month. Cargo tonnage was down 2.8 percent. International cargo dropped 4.1 percent. However, domestic operations posted a surprising 3.2 percent increase.
