

Aviation Department

July was another good summer month for LGA as it continued growing, with YTD passenger traffic up 5.3 percent. Combined international and domestic traffic in July was up 4.2 percent. Delta's commitment to make LGA its domestic hub returned double-digit growth. The airline increased domestic seat capacity by 7.2 percent and carried 106,000 more passengers, providing the biggest boost to LGA's 3.9 percent gain in domestic traffic. Southwest, JetBlue and Spirit collectively offered 6.1 percent more seat capacity and carried 34,000 more domestic passengers. The international sector continued its strong growth with WestJet and Delta lifting it 9 percent with additional services to major Canadian cities. YTD freight at LGA increased 1.2 percent due to strong domestic growth for the last two months.
