

Aviation Department

Although passenger traffic fell 14.5 percent, two of the airports three airlines continued to report small gains. JetBlue, the airport's top-ranked carrier, along with US Airways, collectively carried 1,185 more passengers. Continuing its downward services and capacity reduction, Delta carried 6,500 fewer passengers, offsetting gains by other airlines. Weak activity at UPS and structural changes at FedEx resulted in a 8.5 percent decrease of cargo at SWF, the fifth straight month of contracting volumes since March 2013.
