

Aviation Department

July 2014 was the fourth consecutive record-setting month. With 5.2 million passengers traveling through the airport this month, YTD July settled at an all-time high of 30.3 million passengers. This represents a 4.9% jump compared to the same period last year. Both domestic and international traffic increased, 4.6 and 5.8% respectively. As strong as domestic travel has been at JFK with 2.5% increase YTD, it trails international passenger traffic growth, which is up a hefty 7.1%. JetBlue, Norwegian, Tame, Etihad and Emirates collectively carried 102,200 more passengers on their international destinations. Even though tonnage grew 2.6% at JFK, it was relatively slow growth compared to cargo development in previous months.
