

Aviation Department

Just like JFK, LaGuardia also experienced its fourth consecutive record-setting month, reaching an all-time high of 15.4 million passengers YTD out of which 95% were domestic travelers. Even though LGA's international traffic was down 0.2% for the month, it is up 7.2% YTD. The better news is with our domestic travel, up 2.8% this month, which pushed the YTD July for the airport up to 0.7%. Three out of four carriers serving international destinations carried 11,400 more passengers, with destinations to Canada accounting for 80% of the gain. The carriers combined served 90,000 more passengers on their domestic routes, with Southwest accounting for 55% of the increase. Delta and United together contributed 37%. Among domestic destinations, Houston, Chicago, Miami, Richmond, Greensboro and Louisville dominated this month's traffic.
