Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

## Aviation Department

Our airports have served 67 million passengers YTD July, 2.5% higher than passenger traffic for the same period last year and easily eclipsing the pre-recession high by 5.3%. Following a record-setting June, July set a new peak with 11.1 million passengers traveling through our region, a 3.6 % increase over July of last year. Domestic traffic was up 2.4% this month, putting YTD in the black by 0.8%. International traffic continued to roar with a 5.6% increase for the month. As reported previously, this increase is a function of solid summer bookings, relatively high load factors, and seat capacity expansion in international destinations. Region's cargo posted a strong 5.8 % increase as domestic jumped 7.6% and international increased 4.9%.
