

## Aviation Department

Passenger traffic fell 7.3% on a 6.6% reduction in seat capacity, an improvement over the first quarter -9.7% average. Domestic traffic was down 7.2% on a 6.6% drawdown of seat capacity. International traffic was down 7.4%, but better than the 9.3% drop in May on 6.9% fewer seats. Although traffic to Mexico was half of what it was last year, Caribbean and Latin American markets were up 0.5% and 15%, respectively, in June.
