

Aviation Department

LaGuardia finished off the first half of the year with a 6.2% decrease in monthly passenger traffic (vs. June 2008), its best monthly performance since October, on a decrease in seat capacity of 8.8%. Domestic and international traffic fell 6.0% and 10.2% on capacity cuts of 8.9% and 6.2%, respectively. Southwest initiated service in late June to Baltimore and Chicago Midway, and carried 53k passengers. Definitely a positive development.
