

JFK's June passenger traffic is up 3.5%, but YTD June traffic is down 0.9% as seat capacity fell 4.8%. YTD cargo is also up 25%. The focus has been on the international sector where strict seat discipline combined with pentup demand generated YTD June international passenger growth of 5.8%. The Asian Pacific Region led the growth with 19.4% or a net gain of 185K. In contrast, YTD June domestic traffic is down 6.5%, the result of a weak domestic demand, a 9% contraction of domestic seat capacity and to a limited degree the closure of Bay runway.
