

## Aviation Department

JFK's YTD June traffic was up 4.4% as seat capacity increased 5.2%. Growth was balanced as domestic and international passenger levels reached 4.1% and 4.8% respectively. Similar to the 1st quarter pattern, American Airlines was the primary driver of domestic growth as it added a net of nearly 481,000 passengers, and increased domestic seat capacity in excess of 35,000 to multiple Florida destinations and Las Vegas. AA also led international growth. YTD cargo grew 4.1%.
