

## Aviation Department

As of YTD June, airlines have reduced the airport's seat capacity by 1.3% but planes remain full as passenger traffic continued its growth with a gain of 4%. YTD June International and domestic traffic grew 3.5% and 4.6% respectively, led by Caribbean Air and JetBlue. Again the disappointment was in the cargo sector where cargo continued to remain weak and YTD June cargo fell 7.4%.
