

Though seat capacity was virtually unchanged, LGA remained the fastest growing among our airports as YTD June passenger traffic grew a strong 6.1%. YTD June domestic passengers grew 5.3%. Domestic growth leader Delta increased its domestic capacity by 17%, using its newly acquired slots to expand services to 17 new domestic destinations, including Dallas-Fort Worth, Miami and Buffalo. American and JetBlue rounded out the top three with an aggregate net contribution of 150,000 passengers. The international sector continued its double-digit drive with growth of 23%, led by Delta's services to Nassau and by American, Air Canada and new carrier West Jet's services to Toronto.
