

# THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JUNE 2012 TRAFFIC REPORT

## Aviation Department

SWF continues to experience passenger attrition, as June passenger traffic fell nearly 9%, pushing the YTD level down 2.3%. Contributing factors include Delta's 1.4% seat reduction of flights to Detroit. More importantly, JetBlue, the No. 1 carrier at the airport, switched from 158-seat A320s to smaller 100-seat regional jets for flights to Fort Lauderdale and Orlando. This led to a decline of 21%, or 11,800 fewer departing seats on these routes. Prospects are expected to worsen as Delta is scheduled to drop services to Atlanta effective September 1.
