

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic rose 1.6% in June and YTD June passenger traffic rose 1.1%. Similar to the first quarter, the international sector generated all the growth as seat capacity grew 4% and YTD June traffic rose 5%. Mexico led the international growth with a net addition of 198,00, as the Cancun market experienced a nearly 80% seat capacity growth. In contrast the weakness detected in the domestic sector in the first quarter continued as YTD June seat capacity fell 1.7% and passenger traffic declined 2.6%. The decline was attributable to Jetblue Delta and Virgin America who jointly reduced domestic capacity by 4% and, collectively carried 450,174 fewer passengers. Again the disappointment was in the cargo sector where cargo continued to remain weak and YTD June cargo fell 1.6%.
