

Aviation Department

LGA continued to be the fastest-growing of our facilities as June traffic grew 2.2%, placing YTD-June growth at 5.5%. With domestic seats (96% of total seats) up 1.3%, domestic traffic rose 4%, and contributed a net of 466,000 passengers. Growth was led by Delta, which used its new slots to add a net of nearly a million passengers, followed by JetBlue with a net gain of 260,000 passengers. The international sector also continued its double-digit growth that began in June 2012, with the arrival of Canadian low cost carrier WestJet. International traffic grew 35.8%, led in addition to WestJet, by Delta with services to Montreal, Toronto and Halifax.
