

## Aviation Department

SWF continues to experience passenger attrition, as June passenger traffic fell nearly 20.5%, pushing the YTD level down 20%. Overall seat capacity fell 22.5% and all three carriers operated fewer seats and carried fewer passengers. With reduced services to Florida destinations, JetBlue, the No. 1 ranked carrier, carried 2,300 fewer passengers. With the cessation of services to its connecting hub at Atlanta, Delta lost the most seats (-53,120) and the most passengers (-35,000).
