

Aviation Department

SWF traffic was down 5.1% in the first quarter, but rebounded strongly in the second quarter, pushing YTD June traffic up 0.9%. The gains are attributed mainly to Allegiant Air, which is averaging about 2,200 passengers monthly. JetBlue, the No. 1 carrier at the airport, reduced seat capacity to Orlando by 37% and carried 13,000 fewer passengers.
