

Aviation Department

SWF's traffic performance continues to deteriorate as YTD- June passenger and seat capacity fell 10.7% and 9% respectively, and the airport carried 16,000 fewer passengers. Delta reduced seat capacity by 11% to Detroit, and carried nearly 4,000 fewer passengers. US Airways reduced capacity by 23%, discontinued Air Wisconsin service to Philadelphia, and carried 11,000 fewer passengers. JetBlue and Allegiant showed no net gains.
