### Aviation Department

LGA's seven consecutive years of record growth ended in 2017 as passenger traffic fell 1 percent—the first decline since 2009. Down 2.1 percent, the domestic sector (which makes up 93 percent of the total traffic) was responsible for the decline. With the exception of Delta, nearly all airlines carried fewer passengers as overall seat capacity was trimmed 1 percent. In spite of inconveniences created by construction, the international sector set a new record with 2.1 million passengers, up 17.7 percent and surpassing the previous mark of 1.8 million set last year. Though American led the growth with a net contribution of 105,457 passengers, the other three carriers providing international service—WestJet, Air Canada and Delta—also grew.
