Passenger traffic increased to a record of 2.7 million passengers - a gain of 165,138 travelers. LGA's 6.5 percent rise - the second highest growth rate among our airports - was led by the domestic sector which grew 7.7 percent. AA/US Airways and Delta were the top contributors to LGA's growth, as they jointly carried 146,308 additional domestic passengers. Airlines grew domestic seat capacity by 1.9 percent - 56,120 additional seats. International traffic continued to struggle as it fell by 8.9 percent. The fall in international passengers was attributable to American Eagle/Envoy and Delta, which saw a combined drop of 27,935 international passengers. LGA's total cargo activity increased 9 percent - up 53 short tons. Growth was led by the domestic sector, which had a gain of 9.2 percent. International cargo, which represents less than 1 percent of total cargo at LGA, dropped 20 percent.
