

## Aviation Department

YTD March traffic was flat. Though domestic capacity was down 3.7%, planes were fuller as domestic traffic gained 1.6%, led by UA/CO, US Airways and Southwest, which collectively added 106,000 passengers. With YTD international seat capacity down 6% and dominant hub carrier UA/CO carrying 5% fewer passengers, it was no surprise that YTD international traffic declined 3.1%. Consolidation of services away from EWR to JFK by Air France, Alitalia and Lot Polish also contributed to the decline. Cargo continued to remain weak as the YTD March level fell 7.2%.
