

Aviation Department

SWF traffic was down 5.1% in the first quarter. Though the new low-cost carrier Allegiant contributed a net of 7,496 passengers, it was not enough to overcome the drag on stats by JetBlue, the No. 1 carrier at the airport, which reduced seat capacity to Orlando by 37% and carried 10,000 fewer passengers. SWF's first-quarter cargo was down 25.5 %, due primarily to lower volumes carried by FedEx.
