With a preponderance of flights to Florida destinations, ACY enjoyed seasonal first quarter growth of 6.4%. While the 6% monthly average growth is unlikely to be sustained in April due to the loss of United Airlines, the airport is anticipating a summer traffic boost as Air Canada and scheduled-charter operator Choice Air begin seasonal operations from Toronto, Nashville and Miami.
