

## Aviation Department

YTD March passenger traffic is up 3.6%, led by the domestic sector which rose 4.2%. With domestic seat capacity up only 1%, the domestic gain was disproportionately impacted by the huge 10.3% weather-related gain in February. All the major carriers carried more passengers except Southwest Airlines. YTD March international traffic grew 2.5% on a 1% seat capacity gain. Growth was led by Cathy Pacific, JetBlue and Austrian Air. Incidentally, hub carrier United handled 46,000 fewer passengers. The international growth was limited to only three regions: Caribbean (+22%) the Pacific (5.8%) and Mexico (+6.8%). Though the region's cargo recovery began with the international sector at JFK, EWR is now sustaining the recovery as YTD March cargo grew 9.6%.
