

Aviation Department

Traffic performance continues to underperform. March traffic was down 14%. This help push first quarter passenger traffic down 12% and seat capacity also fell 13%. Only low-cost carrier Allegiant grew. U.S. Airways' discontinuation of Air Wisconsin service to Philadelphia resulted in a loss of 7,800 passengers, and Delta also carried 2,600 fewer passengers to Detroit.
