

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic declined 6.1% on 4.3% fewer seats. Domestic traffic fell 4.0% on 3.1% fewer seats while international traffic fell 8.6%, disappointing after not falling in April. Delta/Northwest and affiliates continued to buck the trend and managed to grow traffic at JFK 3.9% in May on a 2.7% increase in seats. Consistent with the pattern established in recent months, its growth was focused on domestic markets which were up 9.3% while international traffic fell 7.4%.
