

Aviation Department

LaGuardia traffic increased 3 percent in May on a 6 percent rise in seat capacity, dropping the average load factor by just under 3 points. Domestic traffic grew 3.3 percent, while international traffic fell by 3.3 percent; on 6.4 percent more domestic and 1.1 percent fewer international seats. It is worth remembering that last year LGA benefitted traffic wise from the Bay runway closure at Kennedy.
