

Aviation Department

For the first time this year monthly passenger traffic fell 0.6% in spite of a 2.5% gain in seat capacity. International traffic fell 4.4%, reflecting the nearly 1% decline in Continental/United traffic and the absence of Eva, Air France and Iceland Express from the airport. Domestic traffic gained 1.4% though CO/UA carried 64K fewer passengers. Nevertheless YTD May traffic remains encouraging at 5%. Improvements in overall FedEx and UPS's international cargo in May help cushion the airports cargo drop to only 1.9%, improving YTD May cargo decline to -10% from -12%.
