

Aviation Department

With a 1.5% gain in overall seat capacity in May, LGA remained the fastest growing among our airports as passenger traffic grew a strong 5% in May, pushing YTD May growth up to 6.3%. Domestic passenger traffic was up 4.7%, but the international sector continued its double digit drive with a growth of 13.2% on a 14.7% seat capacity gain. International gains continued to be led by Delta' services to Nassau and by AA and Air Canada to Toronto. Cargo was up 2.5% in May.
