

Aviation Department

Although passenger traffic fell 18.3%, May was the first month when two out of three airlines reported small but positive gains. JetBlue, the airport's top-ranked airline, along with US Airways collectively carried 760 more passengers. Continuing its services and capacity reduction, Delta carried 6,500 fewer passengers, thereby offsetting the small gains of other airlines. By October this year, we anticipate that the volume of monthly declines will stabilize around 4% to 6% as year-over-year data is projected to catch up to 2012 reductions in service by Delta.
