

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ MAY 2014 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

With 2.4% decrease, EWR was the only facility that experienced passenger attrition this month. Even though international traffic grew 2.2%, a 4.6% decline in domestic travel pulled overall traffic down because domestic makes up two-thirds of all passenger traffic at the airport and is dominated by United. Coincidentally, United was the sole carrier to experience domestic passenger decrease. It decreased domestic seat capacity by 10.2% and carried 131,600 fewer passengers. A relatively better performance in international traffic was because of Cathay Pacific, Delta, JetBlue, IcelandAir and Air Canada, which combined carried 48,500 more passengers. Cargo tonnage fell 7.4% at EWR putting YTD down to 6.9%.
