

Aviation Department

Yet again, JFK had its best May ever with 4.5 million passengers traveling through the airport. As mentioned in our previous reports, the current spring numbers reflected traffic usually seen in peak month of summer. Even though domestic traffic declined slightly at 0.6%, a strong 9.8% boost in international travel pushed monthly rate up 4.8%. This is great news for the airport because the YTD is up 3.9% compared to the same period last year. The top ten airlines that contributed the most to international traffic were Delta, Norwegian, Emirates, JetBlue, Etihad, KLM, Aerolineas Argentina, Turkish, TAM Brazilian Airlines and Tame Airlines. Cargo tonnage at JFK continued to grow and was up 4.3%. Airport's international cargo was the largest contributor not only to the airport but also to the region overall.
