

Aviation Department

Similar to JFK, LaGuardia airport also had its best May ever with traffic up 3.2%. The airport served 2.4 million passengers out of which 95% were domestic travelers. LGA's YTD traffic is down 0.2% due to previous weakness in the domestic market even though international traffic is up 9% YTD. Four out of five carriers serving international destinations carried 14,500 more passengers with Canadian destinations accounting for almost 11,000. Domestic passenger traffic, which also increased 3.2%, saw additional 100,000 passengers for the month with Southwest, Delta and United combined, accounting for 87,700. Among domestic destinations, Houston, Washington DC, Miami, Chicago and Richmond were the biggest beneficiaries.
