

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic increased 3.1% at LGA with domestic and international travel growing 3% and 3.5% respectively. Domestic travel, which makes up approximately 94% of airport's traffic, was boosted primarily by Southwest and JetBlue's seat capacity expansion. These carriers accounted for the majority of 86,900 incremental domestic passengers. International travel increased due primarily to Air Canada and Delta's seat capacity expansion to Montreal and Toronto.
