

Aviation Department

LaGuardia had its best monthly performance since 2005 and single-handedly propelled the region into positive territory. The low-cost segment registered impressive gains. US Airways traffic increased 20.2%, Jetblue was up 14.2%, Frontier 24.0%, AirTran 21.5% and Spirit was up 5.1%. Southwest flew 47.6K passengers on the Midway and Baltimore routes it introduced last summer.
