Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

For the second time this year, the region's passenger traffic fell as Nov. traffic declined 0.6%, following a 3.7% drop in October. Domestic traffic was down 2% but international traffic was up 2.6%. Residual impact of Hurricane Sandy contributed to the domestic decline. Due to strong growth in the previous nine months, YTD traffic growth remained robust at 3.3%. With a 0.7% decline in Nov. and a YTD Nov. decline of 6.4%, cargo continues to remain very weak. Due to the continued weakness, we anticipate that the magnitude of the 2012 cargo decline will probably be larger than the 4% decline predicted for this year.
